## Back to School 2017-2018 - MEMO #2 | August 16, 2017

### Student Transportation Information

As of **August 21, 2017**, you will be able to access your child's transportation information (24/7) by clicking on the "Back to School" button on the welcome page of our website ([www.swlauriersb.qc.ca](http://www.swlauriersb.qc.ca)). **Please verify the bus information again one or two days before the first day of school, since the times might have been modified.**



You will need to provide the following to access the information:

- 1) **Student file number:** 7 digit number on the report card
- 2) **Your postal code**
- 3) **Parent e-mail address or the guardian's e-mail address**

It is important that your child's school has the accurate information on file (home address, joint custody, babysitter address). **If there was a change of address during the summer, please make sure to inform the school secretary.**

### Laval High Schools

#### **STL – NEW: SPECIALLY ENCODED OPUS CARD WITH PREFERENTIAL SWL RATE**

As of September 1<sup>st</sup>, admissible students attending Laval Junior Academy or Laval Senior Academy will be able to travel on STL buses for \$16.80/month. This preferential rate will be available from September to June.

To obtain this preferential rate, your child must present a **specially encoded OPUS card with his picture**.

Students attending Laval Junior Academy or Laval Senior Academy will also have access to their bus routes in **mid-August** by clicking on the "Back to School" button on the welcome page of our website ([www.swlauriersb.qc.ca](http://www.swlauriersb.qc.ca)) under the STL logo or directly on the STL website ([www.stl.laval.qc.ca](http://www.stl.laval.qc.ca)) under "Students' Zone", "Integrated school bus routes".





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## **Transportation Requests**

During the back-to-school period (August 21 to September 29), please note that all transportation requests will be prioritized in the following manner:

- 1) Students without a bus stop
- 2) Change of address
- 3) Change of bus stop
- 4) Accommodations

Our goal is to give transportation access to students in a timely manner keeping in mind their safety. There is always a turnaround period of a few days to process any requests completely. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this peak period.

## **Daycare Services VS Transportation Services**

Transportation services can be assigned to students attending daycare on a sporadic basis as long as it is a **REGULAR** schedule (Ex.: Daycare in the mornings and transportation services in the afternoons).

Students attending daycare services on a **full-time basis** (all mornings and all afternoons) will be registered as daycare users. Therefore, there will be no transportation services assigned to them.

If you plan on using daycare services for the 2017-2018 school year, it is important that your child's school has the accurate information on file since this might impact the transportation services. Please contact your child's school to verify your information.

Any other relevant information regarding transportation will be posted on our website during the course of the school year.
