A few points of information for you. Report cards are available on Mozaïk. The following documents can be found on our new school website:





#### New Caretaker:

Our dear Mr. Reggie has retired. We wish him all the best as he starts a new chapter in his life with extra time to spend with his loved ones. We celebrated him at a school-wide assembly the last week of school where students had the opportunity to show him how much he is appreciated.

I am happy to welcome Mr. Thomas Linhares as our new caretaker.

#### Phasing in of French Immersion Program:

We are happy to announce that for the 2024-25 school year students in Kindergarten to grade 4 will be following a French immersion program and this program will be replacing the français de base program. We will be phasing in the program over three years. The immersion program will be implemented in 2025-26 for grade 5 and in 2026-27 for grade 6.

This change entails an increased focus on reading and writing. Each of the three competencies (communicates in French, understands oral and written texts in French, and produces oral and written texts in French) will be weighted equally at 33.3%.

Over the past few years, we have put in place a number of changes to improve our French program. These include creating a bilingual K4-K5, increasing French instruction minutes to 300 (1 hour per day), changing CCQ to French language of instruction.
