

Our Lady of Peace Elementary School Governing Board is pleased to present the 2024-2025 Annual Report.

OLP Elementary School is an English Elementary School of the SWLSB. It is located at 3900 rue Nicole, Fabreville, Laval, Quebec. The school is located in a quiet residential area and services 214 children from Kindergarten to grade 6.

The OLP community is comprised of the Fabreville and Ste-Rose populations. OLP rates a 4 in the socio-economic index (the ratings range from 1 to 10; 1 being the most advantageous).

A MEES funded daycare service is in operation in the school with 5 daycare educators on staff. This year we have 86 students registered at Daycare as regular users. This includes students who attend from 1 to 5 days per week on a weekly basis. Of the 86 registered students, 78 attend 3 to 5 days a week, 5 attend 2 days a week and 3 attend 1 day a week. We also have 14 sporadic users. Our total of regular daycare users this year has decreased from 93 to 86. We currently have 69 daycare users already registered for the next school year.

PPO, Our Parent Participation Organization participates in motivating our students by contributing to the enrichment of our education activities and school life. Our Chairperson was Melanie Machado Branco and our PPO had 15 regular members.

Funds raised by PPO were also allocated to a variety of school-wide activities, which included, Fun Day, Graduations, Halloween Dance, Book Fair, etc....

Our Annual General Assembly took place on Wednesday, August 28th, 2024 from 5:30 pm to 6:30 pm.
